Students begin the program in Fall semester and begin by taking the MBA core curriculum along with other first-year MBA students. During remaining semesters students will take a combination of MHA and MBA core classes.

Graduation Requirements and Application:

- Total Credit Hours: 84.5 86
- Neither degree is awarded until all degree requirements for each degree are completed.
- Submit this MBA/MHA Degree Requirement Checklist to your MBA Advisor the semester *prior* to graduation.
- Meet with both your MHA and MBA academic advisors prior to applying for graduation to check progress towards the joint degree requirements.
