#### **Scholarship Overview**

A separate application is not required for scholarships, and all admitted students are considered for merit-based awards. Criteria for selection of awards include demonstrated excellence in academic or professional pursuits. Notification of awards is included with admission decisions.

On average, 80% of enrolled students receive scholarship awards ranging from \$5,000 to \$25,000. The amount of a scholarship award depends on the competitiveness of the admitted applicant pool.

Applicants who do not qualify for resident tuition may be eligible to receive non-resident tuition assistance. All out-of-state applicants are automatically considered for this waiver.
