#### ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS:

The MPA/MHA dual-degree program is a joint effort between the College of Social and Behavioral Science and the David Eccles School of Business. Students can complete the MPA/MHA dual degree program is approximately three years of year-round study. Students can start taking MHA classes as early as their first semester enrolled in the program.

To qualify for the joint MPA/MHA program, you must meet the following requirements:

- Complete **71-74** credit hours
- Complete MRP (Major Research Paper) requirement; see the MPA Advisor for more information.

Graduation Requirements and Application:

- Neither degree is awarded until all requirements for each degree are completed.
- Submit this MPA/MHA Degree Requirement Checklist to your MPA Advisor the semester **prior** to graduation.
- Meet with both your MHA and MPA advisors prior to applying for graduation to check progress towards the joint degree requirements.
