The MHA/MBA dual degree program offered by the David Eccles School of Business allows students to earn two masters degrees in three years.

Students begin the program in Fall semester and begin by taking the MBA core curriculum along with other first-year MBA students. During remaining semesters students will take a combination of MHA and MBA core classes.

Graduation Requirements and Application:

- Total Credit Hours: **86.5 – 91**
- Neither degree is awarded until all degree requirements for each degree are completed.
- Submit this MHA/MBA Degree Requirement Checklist to your MBA Advisor the semester **prior** to graduation.
- Meet with both your MHA and MBA academic advisors prior to applying for graduation to check progress towards the joint degree requirements.
