## Scholarship Overview

Applicants with a complete MSBA application by the scholarship deadline and a minimum 550 GMAT score or approved GMAT waiver are eligible to apply for admissions scholarships. A separate scholarship application will be emailed to eligible applicants after notification of their admissions decision. Criteria for awards include demonstrated excellence in academic or professional pursuits, as assessed in your program and scholarship applications.

## 10% Scholarship for U of U Alumni

### Capstone Project

Students complete a hands-on capstone project as the culmination of their degree. The capstone is an in-depth, consulting-based project where students put their classroom knowledge to work to execute data analysis for industry partners. The capstone project is three credit hours completed over three semesters.

### Prepare for the aCAP Certification

MSBA students will be prepared to sit for the INFORMS Associate Certified Analytics Professional (aCAP) exam upon graduation, a globally recognized analytics certification. The MSBA curriculum is designed to ensure students are well versed in aCAP exam concepts, including analytics domain knowledge, data, model building, lifecycle management and business problem framing. Students are responsible for the exam cost.

With a number of Fortune 500 companies located in and near Salt Lake City, MSBA graduates have access to job opportunities at some of the most prestigious corporations in the United States. A dedicated career coach helps students prepare to enter this growing, competitive market.

### Work-Compatible Class Schedule
