- O Register to present & present at the <u>Undergraduate Research Symposium</u>. (Check your UMail account for notifications about the symposium.)
- O Submit your thesis abstract to the <u>Undergraduate Research Journal</u>.
- O Have your Honors Faculty Advisor, your thesis mentor, & the department chair sign your finished thesis.
- O Submit a hard copy of your finished thesis to the Honors College. Also, provide an electronic copy & submit the <u>USpace Permission Form</u>, so others can see your hard work! (If your Honors Faculty Advisor & thesis mentor do not specify an earlier due date, your thesis is due the **last day of classes** of your final semester.)
